

Make plans to attend "Chats 4 Life" and "What about Mondays?" in the coming weeks and months.





> Create a Y4Life Team in your school, a group of youth dedicated to becoming Gospelmotivated voices for life and sharing that message with the school and community.


Pray for classmates who are ill.

Create computer generated or handmade Valentine's cards for each person at your school. Include a life-affirming note inside.






