


Communion of Saints/Community




Learn and practice Gospel-motivated apologetics for life with friends.

John 13:34




Create computer-generated or handmade Valentine's cards for each person at your school. Include a life-affirming note inside.




Create a Y4Life Team in your school, a group of youth dedicated to becoming Gospel-motivated voices for life and sharing that message with the school and community.



Make a phone call to a friend you haven't spoken to in a while.




Share an umbrella, hold a door, or help someone clean up. Find a way to show someone you care about them.




Pray for classmates who are ill.



Start a donation at your school to support a for-life ministry.

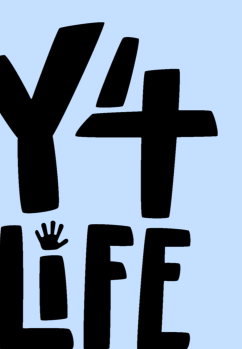


Make plans to attend "Chats 4 Life" and "What about Mondays?" in the coming weeks and months.

Politics/Political Action

Speak well of God's institution of government.

Recognize that we depend on God, not the government, for our salvation and daily bread.

Encourage others and find ways to engage in political action (e.g., sidewalk counseling).

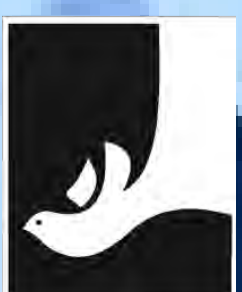

Speaking in Love

Share positive life-affirming messages (e.g., bulletin boards, weekly bulletins, personal messages, etc.).

Find opportunities to uphold those God has placed in your various vocations.

Plan a Life Sunday.

Give thanks to those in your life.
