Track a baby's growth in a classroom or Sunday school when a sibling is going to be born.

Educate community members on Safe Haven boxes and laws.

Affirm and uphold the vocations of mother, father, and siblings through prayers, family outings, and Mother's and Father's day celebrations.

Provide changing stations for babies and toddlers in men's bathrooms.

Create self-care packages for women who have just had a child. Consider a spa pack, gift cards to restaurants, and coupons for free babysitting from congregation members.

Share Y4Life Human Development brochures.

Ask pastors to speak and preach publicly about the sanctity of life.

Pray for unborn babies and for their families.
