Adoption

Have a church celebration to welcome the newly adopted child into the church family.

Throw a get-to-know-you party in a neighborhood or classroom for families who are fostering/adopting.

Hold a "dresser drive" or "sprinkle shower" for families who are adopting a child.

Teach children about the gift of adoption.

Provide information about life-affirming, Christian adoption agencies.

Offer help around the house for foster and adoptive families, especially on days when case workers are visiting or in the days leading up to the visit.

Give foster/adopted children a Bible or Catechism.

Hold a Bible study on how we are adopted sons and daughters of God.

Prenatal Diagnosis of Disability

Celebrate the lives of all children, even those who, because of disability, will be taken to heaven when they are young.

Hold fundraisers to help cover the costs of caring for a child with disabilities.

Offer LFL disability resources.

Create a meal train for families who have a child in the NICU with a disability following birth.

Offer comfort, support, and pastoral counseling to families who have received a prenatal diagnosis of disability.

Lead a Bible study on the gift of children and God's plan for each person.

Research and provide lists of resources for families raising a child with disabilities.

Host an event to learn more about Down Syndrome, the helps available, and the joys of raising a child with Down Syndrome.

Unplanned/Surprise Pregnancy

Connect families that have children of similar ages.
