Christian Confession and Gospel-Motivated Speaking

Practice de-escalation techniques when possible.

Praise pastors when they speak open about life issues.

Spend time in the Word so you are better equipped to be a Gospel-motivated voice.

Build a "Life Library" with resources addressing life issues.

"But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves." - James 1:22

Encourage your congregation to use LFL's Life Thoughts and Life Quotes in the church bulletin. Develop encouraging and uplifting phrases to use when speaking to others.

Reach out to your representatives when life issues are being voted on.

Wear life-affirming clothing and accessories.

Research and vote for life-affirming representatives.

Just as ... I AN Persecution

Share the names of groups of people who are experiencing persecution and add them to prayer lists.

Encourage, uplift, and pray for those experiencing persecution.

Lead a Bible study on martyrs of the faith.

Take a Sabbath rest to be rejuvenated and spiritually strengthened in the face of persecution.
