# Day 4: Those with Disabilities are Indispensable.

Send cards and gifts (quilts, fruit baskets, etc.) from individuals and the congregation during major holidays. Ask those with disabilities to participate in the gift-giving.

Ask someone with disabilities to help throw a birthday party or other event.

> Sponsor a prom for those with disabilities.



**Similar to Christmas** Caroling, plan and participate in Lenten Caroling, bringing hymns to nursing homes and group homes and encouraging residents to sing along.

**Plan an** outing for someone with disabilities.



Spend time getting to know and building a friendship with someone who has a disability.

Ask a Speaker from LFL or Bethesda to best serve those with disabilities in a life-affirming Way.

## Day 4: Those with Disabilities are Indispensable.

Engage in an empathy activity by limiting your abilities for a short time. (Place Vaseline on your glasses to simulate vision impairment. Place stiff gloves on your hands to limit movement. Wear earplugs for hearing impairment.)

Ask an individual with a disability to speak on his/hen disability.

Create an educational event that focuses on a specific disability seen in your church. Ask an individual with that disability to be an expert on the panel discussion. VOLUNTEER TO TUTOR OR TEACH A NEW SKILL TO SOMEONE WITH A DISABILITY. ASK TO LEARN A NEW SKILL FROM HIM OR HER.

Volunteer to aid a disabled member of the congregation.

> Volunteer to put a brail Bible together.

Offer to babysit for a family who has a child with disabilities.

> Make participation in Service activities possible for those with disabilities.

#### Day 4: Those with Disabilities Are Indispensable!

Volunteer at nursing homes; read stories to those who are blind or have lost their sight.

Donate items to a residential home.

Sponsor a child with disabilities through Children's Christian Concern Society, World Vision, or another local organization.

PARTICIPATE IN OR START A WEEKLY BIBLE STUDY FOR THOSE WITH COGNITIVE DISABILITIES. INCLUDE A CRAFT AND SOCIAL TIME.

CREATE LARGE PRINT BULLETINS FOR CHAPEL; PHOTOCOPY NOTES FOR THOSE WHO HAVE DIFFICULTY WRITING. REQUEST PRINTED SERMONS FOR THOSE HARD OF HEARING.

ASK THOSE WITH A DISABILITY HOW TO MAKE YOUR CHURCH MORE DISABILITY FRIENDLY.



ASK THOSE WITH DISABILITIES HOW THEY WANT TO HELP SHARE THE FAITH WITH OTHERS, AND WORK TO MAKE THOSE OPPORTUNITIES AVAILABLE.

PRAY FOR THOSE WHO HAVE DISABILITIES AND ASK THEM TO PRAY FOR YOU.
