


End of Life Issues

More than 40,000 infants and children die annually. Half of childhood deaths occur in infancy, and two-thirds occur in the neonatal period due to congenital and chromosomal abnormalities.



The prevalence of US children currently living with lifethreatening or chronic, complex conditions is more than 400,000.



1 in 10 homebound elderly adults (60+ years of age) experience abuse, neglect, and exploitation.



Facts to Know

FACT 01


Physician-assisted suicide is permitted in: Hawaii, Washington, Oregon, California, Montana, Colorado, District of Columbia, New Jersey, Vermont, and Maine.

FACT 02

As many as 80% of patients have no healthcare provider witnessing the ingestion of the lethal dose.

FACT 03

In the last 15 years, 8,498 people were given prescriptions for physicianassisted suicide, and 5,188 (61%) of the people died taking the drugs.



FACT 04

Only 40-60% of physician-assisted suicide patients were offered palliative care.

Suicide and elder abuse rates increased where physician-assisted suicide is legal.
